## The FSPA Tournament

The FSPA Tournament is one of Lamka's football league for men's association football clubs. At the top of the Tournament system, it is one of the district's primary football competition.

Contested by 15 clubs in its maiden FSPA Tournament 2013, it operates on a system of promoting football in the district.

Though the FSPA Tournament has no official sponsor (s), it was organized by the Organizing Committee through donations collected from well wishers - under the banner 'Pankhawm Hatna' which means 'Union is Strength'.

Laying its trust in the Tournament's banner 'Pankhawm Hatna', the FSPA General Headquarters directed and sets up the Organizing Committee to organize 'FSPA Tournament 2014' with the sole aim of promoting football in the district of Manipur's Churachandpur.

It would be wise to note that in the year 2013, FSPA Tournament was entitled to a sum of Rs 2000 for the winners and Rs 1000 to the runners up. Now, in the year 2014, winners and runners up are to be awarded Rs 10000 and Rs 5000 respectively showing an immense progress. The current champions are Leventicas United, who won the title in the year 2013.

## Rules and Regulations

- 1) All matches shall be governed in accordance with the Laws of the Game laid down by FIFA.
  - 2) Punctuality and Fair Play shall be the Organizing Committees' top priority.
  - 3) Smoking is not permitted in the technical area during matches.
  - 4) Time schedule must be maintained and followed with full efficiency.
  - 5) Each match shall last 60 minutes, comprising two periods of 30 minutes, with a half-time interval of 5 minutes. If need be, the Organizing Committee may introduce new rules and sanctions for the duration of the matches.
  - 6) At the end of normal playing time, for every drawn match, penalty kicks shall be taken to determine the winner.
  - 7) Every teams/clubs are directed to submit their matchday squad 10 minutes before the scheduled kickoff time.
  - 8) Matchday squad shall comprise 11 first team players with 9 substitutes on the bench.
- SUBSTITUTION:**
- 9) A maximum of 5 substitution can be made during a single match.
- CARDS:**
- 10) Yellow Cards and Red Cards are entitled to a sum of Rs 50 and Rs 100 respectively.
- SUSPENSION:**
- 11) If a player is awarded yellow card for the third time during the tournament, he would then subsequently face a single match ban.
  - 12) Suspension period for a red carded player is a single match. If deemed necessary, the suspension may be revoked or extended by the Organizing Committee.
- DISCIPLINARY MATTERS:**
- 13) Teams/Clubs are advised to
    - a) respect the spirit of fair play, non-violence and the authority of the match officials;
    - b) behave accordingly;
  - 14) Matters regarding fight/conflict, racism and match-fixing may result in direct elimination of the team/club responsible.
  - 15) The conduct and discipline of fans/supporters of a particular teams/clubs lies solely in the hands of the team/club. In the case of fight/conflict/violence among fans, which may result in the disturbance of the course of the tournament, the team/club shall be held responsible.
  - 16) In case a team/club fails to turn up on the given schedule, the opposing team/club shall be awarded a 1:0 victory (in the case group matches, they shall be awarded full 3 points).

## Rules and Regulations

### DISPUTES

17) All disputes in connection with the FSPA Tournament 2014 shall be promptly settled by negotiation.

18) In compliance with the Tournament rules, participating member associations, players and officials may not take disputes to an ordinary court of law but to the exclusive jurisdiction of The Organizing Committee

19) Any disputes between The Organizing Committee and the participating member shall be settled as stipulated by the FSPA General Headquarters.

### PROTESTS:

20) Protests of any kind related to the FSPA Tournament 2014 or matters that have a direct effect on matches organised in the FSPA Tournament 2014 shall be submitted in writing to The Chairman, Organizing Committee.

21) Protests against any incidents that occur during the course of a match shall be made to the referee by the team captain immediately after the disputed incident and before play has resumed, in the presence of the captain of the opposing team.

22) No protests may be made about the referee's decisions regarding facts connected with play. Such decisions are final and not subject to appeal, unless otherwise stipulated in the FSPA Tournament 2014 'rules and regulation'. In that case, protest against that particular match shall be submitted in writing to The Chairman, Organizing Committee within one hour after the match in question and shall be followed up immediately. Otherwise, protest shall be disregarded.

23) If an unfounded or irresponsible protest is lodged, the Organizing Committee may impose a fine.

24) If any of the formal conditions of a protest as set out in these Regulations is not met, such protest shall be disregarded by the competent body. The Organizing Committee shall pass decisions on any protests lodged which may be final.

### REFREEING:

25) The referees, assistant referees and fourth officials (here in after referred to collectively as match officials) for the FSPA Tournament 2014 shall be appointed for each match by the Organizing Committee.

26) The referees (match officials) are given the full authority of decision making during matches. Decisions of the referees are final and not subject to appeal. ( refer rule no.20 )

If deemed necessary, FSPA Tournament 2014 'rules and regulations' may be altered within the course of tournament by the Organizing Committee.

## FIXTURE | FSPA Tournament 2014 proceedings:

### i) *Three knock-out rounds:*

**a. First knock-out round:** All 44 participating teams/clubs are to play their allotted matches. 22 victorious teams/clubs will advance to the second knock-out round.

**b. Second knock-out round:** 11 teams/clubs out of the 22 teams/clubs in the second knock-out round will advance to the third knock-out round.

**c. Third knock-out round:** Out of the 11 advanced teams/clubs to the third knock-out round, 1\* team shall be awarded a **direct qualification** to the round robin league while the other 10 teams/clubs will play their allotted third knock-out round matches to book their place in the round robin league.

**\*Direct qualification** to the round robin league shall be awarded to a single team/club amongst the 11 teams/clubs who were victorious in their second knock-out round.

Conditions to be considered for **direct qualification** (( Conditions are to be determined only from the **Second knock-out round** matches )) :

- a) **Firstly**, goal difference.
- b) **Secondly**, greatest number of goals scored.
- c) **Thirdly**, fair play ( least carded teams/clubs )

If two or more teams are equal on the basis of the above three criteria, the Organizing Committee shall make the necessary decisions.

ii) *Round robin league:* The 5 winners of the third knock-out round matches and the direct qualified team/club shall play the round robin league.

The round robin league shall consist of two groups ( FS & PA ) where in the 6 teams/clubs be divided into groups of 3.

### **Basis of Round Robin League:**

Three points for a win, one point for a draw and no points for a defeat.

In the round robin league format, the ranking in each group shall be determined as follows:

- a) **Firstly**, greatest number of points obtained in all group matches;
- b) **Secondly**, goal difference in all group matches;
- c) **Thirdly**, greatest number of goals scored in all group matches.

iii) *FINAL MATCH:* Winners of both the groups in the round robin league shall play the much anticipated FSPA Tournament 2014 FINAL match.
